



The diocesan investigation of the Augustinian known for his "joyful spirit" and "generous service to the most in need" has concluded

In the parish church of Saint John the Baptist, just a few kilometers from Paris, the diocean investigation concerning the cause for beatification and canonization of the Servant of God Ange Le Proust, a professed priest of the Order of Saint Augustine and Founder of the Congregation of the Siters of Saint Thomas of Villanova, was concluded.

The final session was presided over by the Vicar General of the Diocese of Nanterre, representing His Excellency Monsignor Matthieu Rougé, Bishop of Nanterre, with the participation of the members of the ecclesiastical tribunal, the diocesan chancellor, and the Postulator General of the Order, Fr. Josef Sciberras, OSA.

The celebration gathered a large number of faithful, as reported by the General Postulation. Among those present were Mother Marie José Villain STV, Superior General of the Augusthaina Ststers of Saint Thomas of Villanova, along with a substantial group of nuns, members of the diocesan clergy, friends of the Congregation, and devotees of the Servant




